

### Supply vs Demand?

- Demand has exceeded supply from 2012 thru 2015.
- 2016 Supply appears to be ahead of demand ,still early
- Good hay prices and heavy Midwest winterkill in 2013 pushed sales above demand causing shortages
- Low Seed acres during this cycle and marginal weather have kept supplies low
- USA hay acres consistent at +- 20 million acres


# 2017 Challenges

- Potential inventory problems if 2017 spring sales are down in Dairy belt
- Strong USA currency exchange.. Less competitive in International markets
- Watch out for big crop of Canadian common seed production
- Bug control access i.e. "Transform "



## 2017 Opportunities

- Production of new Quality Traited products .. HarvXtra
- Shortage of high quality hay in the USA each year, never enough!
- New DC administration, changes in EPA?
- Lower fuel prices
- Strong winter, more feed use by grazing animals
- Irrigation water to allow for rotations
- Dairy futures look good .. 2017 4<sup>th</sup> quarter at \$16.66 / cwt.
- Strong US dollar ---- leverage leafcutter bee purchases?
