B. Soil Moisture Monitoring and Soil Health

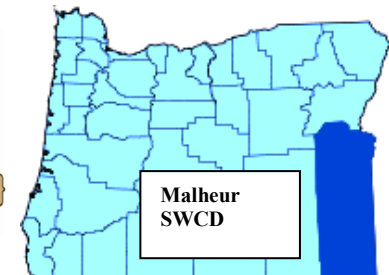
This tour will highlight whole farm automatic, soil moisture monitoring, water, and soil health.

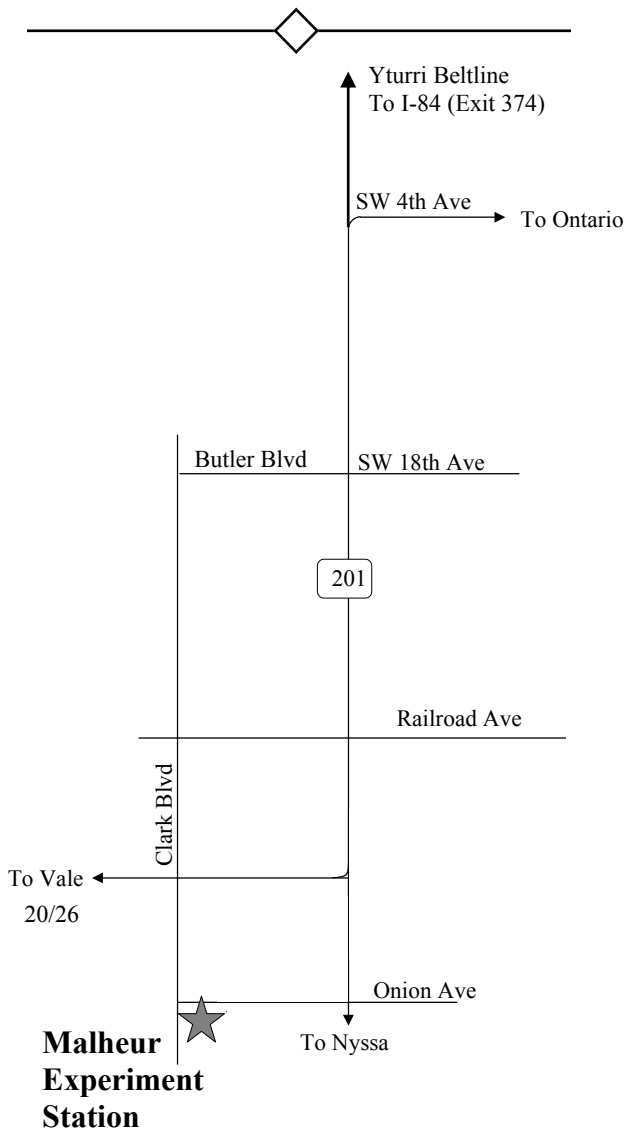
