

## **DEQ Crop Residue Burning Training**

The Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) implemented a Crop Residue Burning (CRB) program in September of 2008. The program requires growers to complete a required "grower training" once every five years. DEQ has developed this training presentation to detail all of the necessary information to properly conduct a field burn in the state of Idaho. Table 1 below details 2009 grower trainings for southern Idaho, online training will continue to be available as well.

The CRB program applies statewide to all lands other than the five Indian Reservations in Idaho. For information on burning on reservations, contact individual Tribes.
